The Dry Creek ripe raspberry and black pepper characteristics blend seamlessly with the black cherry and plum contributed by Alexander Valley fruit. The aroma also holds the alluring vanilla notes that come with oak aging. Along with the fruit and black pepper flavors, hints of blackberry, cocoa and vanilla dance across the palate.
