**Tasting Notes** Dark, inky aromas of spicy fruit tempt you to dive into this Petite Sirah, and when you do the flavors don't disappoint. A generous core of concentrated, chewy black fruit flavors—plum, blackberry, cassis and boysenberry—are fused with spicy cedar, pepper, espresso and a hint of mineral and licorice. The intense flavors broaden and linger into the finish.

This robust Petite needs time to open once the cork is popped. Be sure to stash away some bottles to see how this beauty will age.
