Lush dark cherry, plum and mixed berry layer over coffee and dark chocolate flavors with a sprinkling of white pepper. An excellent accompaniment to your favorite foods — barbequed ribs, eggplant parmesan, grilled chicken breasts, lamb shanks, pork tenderloin and more.
