Tasting Notes Our Sonoma County Zin is a harmonious blend of fruit from Dry Creek Valley (62%) and Alexander Valley (38%). From the deep rich aromas to the lush juicy flavors, this Zin will make you want to sing. Layers of spicy fruit, white pepper, vanilla and toasty oak create enticing aromas. A bounty of luscious fruit flavors—blackberry, raspberry, black cherry and plum—mix with baking spices, black pepper, dark roasted coffee and toasty vanillin oak. The silky tannins, lush flavors laced with nice acidity and a creamy texture provide a well-balanced, hard-to-put-down Zinfandel.
