**Tasting Notes** The perfumey nose offers a fragrant array of jammy blackberry, spicy oak and a hint of plum. A sensual mouthfeel reveals a delicious blend of fruit and spice—raspberry, blackberry, black pepper, creamy vanillin oak and a touch of plum and chocolate. The lush flavors spread across the palate, expanding into a lingering finish.

This wonderful sipping wine will also pair well with braised short ribs or lamb shanks with a tomato and red wine reduction sauce.
